Boston Health Care for the Homeless Program to dedicate new health care facility

Boston Health Care for the Homeless Program will dedicate its new building, Jean Yawkey Place, on Wednesday.

The new building at the corner of Massachusetts Avenue and Albany Street in the South End will house a 104-bed inpatient clinic, a comprehensive primary care clinic, dental clinic, outpatient mental health services, family services and a pharmacy.

BHCHP will also move its research and administrative services to the building, including a new data center. Hopkinton's **EMC Corp.** said it donated some \$250,000 worth of storage hardware, software and services for the facility.

The private, nonprofit BHCHP provides health care services to more than 10,000 homeless men, women and children annually at more than 80 community sites around the city.
