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### **Summary of Position:**

As part of the multidisciplinary HIV team, the case manager will meet with each new patient to assess his or her financial and psycho-social needs. She/he will work with patient to develop and carry out a plan to achieve success in housing, substance abuse treatment and access to other services. The case manager will meet with other members of the team regularly to exchange information about the needs of particular patients. S/he will also be available on an ongoing basis to provide support and referrals as needed to the established patients. S/he will also be available on an ongoing basis to patients for crisis support and psycho-social support.

- Bachelor's Degree (social service or related field preferred)
- Bilingual English/Spanish preferred
- 2 years experience working as a case manager with medically and financially indigent persons preferred
- Experience with HIV clients preferred
- Basic familiarity of HIV disease, how transmitted, prevention methods
